- Presenting the gospel [Acts 1:8; Romans 1:16]
- Providing the opportunity to receive Christ [Acts 2:37-40; Romans 10:8-10]

All Initiative		All Relational	

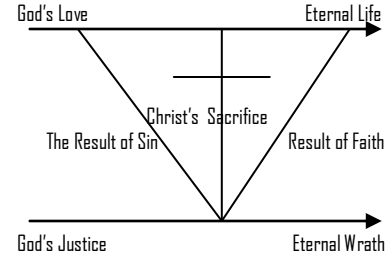
Message: 1 Cor. 15:1-8; Includes an invitation

- Man's Sin - The Problem
- God's Provision - The Solution
- Man's Response - The Applications



## Multiplication Model

Make it Transferable; Demonstration

Follow-up - know how to effectively take someone thru follow-up

## CoJourners

**Explorer** - to discover where they are spiritually

**Guide** - to show them the way to Jesus

**Builder** - to provide bridges over the obstacles along the way

**Mentor** - to encourage them to continue on

Conversation Starters; Study Jesus approaches; Questioning Evangelism; Christian World View; Surveys

- Take others with you every time;
